Dear Readers,

The regular Daylight issues have been in suspense for some time, owing to exceptional difficulties over the winter period. Then I had to engage in writing again on the most urgent matter of the threatened genocide of the Lebanese Christians - so, all other matters had to go by the board. This is a circular to let readers know that the Daylight publishing effort is still in being, though, as previously discussed, it may in future take another form.

LEBANON is the urgent and terrible matter of the day. And how can we go on discussing the error of the Evolutionist philosophy, if we do not give first priority to protest against the open massacres of the Christians of Lebanon, Catholic and Orthodox alike?

For the background. The Lebanese took in the Palestinians, who, on gaining strength, set up their own military bases, and then turned round on their hosts. They were joined by the invading Syrian Army, the two combining to wage a most terrible persecution of the Christians; the gallows in the desecrated churches, even the dead disinterred. The Syrians have been recognised as the "Arab Peacekeeping Force" by U.N.O. (Church in Need report, 3-5 North St., Chichester, W. Sussex).

The Pope has now protested for the fifth time. In fact, we saw in the front pages of the world press the pictures of the 100 days shelling by the Syrian Army of the Christian half of Beirut. Last Christmas the same Syrian artillery dropped 1000 shells on Christian city of Zahlie - reported in all the media.


To explain the U.N.O. mandate. It does not cover north of the Littani River, mid-Lebanon, where the Syrian Army operates, nor south of the Littani in the areas of the P.L.O. bases. No! this mandate of Unifil covers only the southern strip between Lebanon and Israel, which is the southern Christian enclave, acts to separate the Christians from Israel aid, and has declared its intention of penetrating the enclave with Muslim troops of the Syrian controlled Beirut Government. At the same time, U.N.O. looks on at the massacres, by the Syrians north of the Littani and the P.L.O. south of it, on the technical grounds that its mandate does not run in these areas! This duplicity is satanic.

Now the massacres of the Christian communities have attained to a new peak, as witness Zahlie bombarded round the clock by the Syrian artillery. These forsaken Christians have appealed to the Pope and the European Powers. But, incredibly, the so-called Christian nations and all the West have remained in deep silence - seeking their Arab oil?

Please write urgently to your Bishop and M.P., demanding that some action be taken to save the Lebanese Christians from extermination.

Yes, unless Catholics of the West take action, the most ancient Christian people of Lebanon, dating from Apostolic times, is doomed to genocide. We see it happening before our very eyes.
